

NORTH



1. MARINETTE TO MILWAUKEE

- **Hwy 41 south to Green Bay to Lombardi Ave Exit and turn left.** Tour legendary Lambeau Field and the Green Bay Packers Hall of Fame (open 9am-6pm daily). On-site, Curley's Pub serves great food (11am-10pm daily).
- **Go north on Oneida St. to Hwy 54 east to Algoma.** In Algoma take Navarino St. to Bearcats Fish House for samples of fresh smoked fish & fish spreads.
- **Take Hwy 42 south to Manitowoc and turn left on 10th St.** Tour the Wisconsin Maritime Museum for great nautical exhibits and a WWII submarine (open 9am-5pm daily)
- **10th St. becomes Cty LS south to Sheboygan.** Explore downtown along the casual Riverfront Boardwalk. If you need a little luxury, try an award-winning tapas bar or bistro.
- **As you leave Sheboygan, take Hwy 28 West to I-43 South.** At that intersection, check-out Cruisers Frozen Custard and Jumbo Burgers – they're next door to the local Harley dealer.
- **Follow I-43 south to Milwaukee.**

2. HURLEY TO MILWAUKEE

- **Hwy 51 south to Manitowish Waters.** Visit Little Bohemia, a bullet-riddled restaurant made famous in a 1934 shootout between the FBI, John Dillinger and Baby Face Nelson (open 8am-10pm daily).
- **Take Hwy 47 south to Hwy 8 east to Hwy 32 south.** Cruise tree-lined roads through the Nicolet National Forest. Just south of Mountain, Chute Pond County Park offers scenic vistas and a chance to slide down Slippery Rock into the refreshing pond .
- **Take Hwy 29 east to Hwy 41 south to Oshkosh; exit 116, Hwy 44 east.** Tour the EAA Airventure Museum, the most extensive aviation attraction in the world with 250 aircraft including WWII Warbirds in the Eagle Hanger (open 10am-5pm daily).
- **Continue south on Hwy 41 to Milwaukee.**

3. SUPERIOR TO MILWAUKEE

- **Hwy 2 east to Cty U north.** Tour Amnicon Falls State Park with its delightful series of rapids and a covered footbridge. A great rest stop.
- **Return to Hwy 2 east to Cty A at Iron River, then north to Hwy 13.** Turn east and follow the Lake Superior shoreline for spectacular scenery. In Bayfield catch a ferry to Madeline Island or stroll the Lake Superior beaches.
- **Continue south on Hwy 13 to Mellen.** Just north of town, visit Copper Falls State Park to see its 30-foot waterfall pour from a basalt basin.
- **Continue south on Hwy 13 to Phillips.** Visit the Wisconsin Concrete Park, one of America's most whimsical displays of folk art.
- **Continue south on Hwy 13 to Ogema, then east on Hwy 86 to Cty C.** Timm's Hill, the highest point in Wisconsin, offers terrific views from its 130-foot tower.
- **Continue east on Hwy 86 to Tomahawk.** Tour the Harley-Davidson facility here; they make the company's fiberglass parts – windshields, sidecars, and more (free tours 10am-2pm Mon-Fri).
- **Go south on Hwy 51/I-39 to Madison, then east on I-94 to Milwaukee.**

4. HUDSON TO MILWAUKEE

- **I-94 east through Menomonie to Hwy 29 (exit 52) east to Chippewa Falls, take exit 79 east to Hwy 124 north.** Tour the Leinenkugel Brewery, a legendary Wisconsin original (tours 9:30am-4pm Mon-Thur & Sat, Fri 'til 6:30pm, Sun 11am-3pm).
- **Return to Hwy 29 east to Hwy 73 south (exit 118) to Cty H west.** Travel about 3 miles west to the intersection of Cty H, O & G for the perfect HOG photo op.
- **Continue south on Cty G to Hwy 10.** Visit the Highground Veterans Memorial Park, a 140-acre park paying tribute to all veterans. The park's plaza overlooks a half-million acres of spectacular woodland scenery and glacial moraine.
- **Turn east on Hwy 10 to Neillsville, then south on Hwy 73 to Wisconsin Rapids.** Downtown, you can tour the NewPage Paper Mill. See how paper is made, on a machine 5 city blocks long (tours Wed, Thur & Sat at 10am).
- **Follow Hwy 73 southeast to I-39 south to Madison to I-94 east to Milwaukee.**

5. LA CROSSE TO MILWAUKEE

- **I-90 east to Hwy 35 south. Turn right on LaCrosse St.** Grab a bite at Rudy's Drive-In, then travel south on 3rd St. and visit Dave's Guitars, featuring over 300 vintage guitars.
- **Continue south on 3rd St./South Ave to Hwy 35 south.** Enjoy the river views and bluffs along the Mississippi River. Watch the barges go through the lock and dam at Genoa.
- **Take Hwy 56 east.** In Viroqua stop at the funky Main Street Station Public Market for tasty local foods including Sibby's organic ice cream.
- **Take Hwy 82 east.** The hills and valleys you'll cruise are dotted with organic farms, Amish and artist's shops, and spectacular scenery.
- **At Union Center, pick up Hwy 33 east.** The Baraboo Bluffs offer magical views. Need a break? Detour to Devils Lake State Park for a short hike.
- **At Baraboo, pick up Hwy 113 south.** Cross the Wisconsin River on the Merrimac Ferry – a free 10-minute boat ride.
- **Continue southeast on Hwy 113 to Lodi, then east on Hwy 60 to I-94 to Milwaukee.**



6. DUBUQUE TO MILWAUKEE

- **Hwy 35/61 north to Hwy 133 to Potosi.** Visit the National Brewery Museum with its fabulous collection of Breweriana (open 10am-6pm daily). Enjoy casual dining on-site (11am-9pm daily).
- **Head back to 35/61 north to Cty B east.** You'll see a unique Wisconsin landmark, the World's Largest "M" on the hillside east of Platteville.
- **Take Cty G east to Hwy 81 east to Hwy 69 south into Monroe. Turn left on 8th Street.** Visit a cheese factory, or stop for a fresh cheese sandwich and local brew at Baumgartner's on the Square.
- **Return to Hwy 11 east to Hwy 59 east.** Pass by dairy farms and through small towns on your way to the Kettle Moraine State Forest
- **In Eagle take Hwy 67 north through the countryside to I-94 east to downtown Milwaukee.**

7. KENOSHA TO MILWAUKEE

- **Take I-94 west to Cty C west to Wilmot.**
- **Turn right onto Cty W north.** Follow the scenic Fox River
- **Go west on Hwy 50 to Lake Geneva.** Buy sandwiches for a picnic in the park or choose a local lakeside diner.
- **Take Hwy 120 north to East Troy.** Call ahead for tours of the Buell Motorcycle Facility – an H-D subsidiary. (Call 262/642-2020. Tours Mon-Fri, 8-11:30am & 12:30pm.)
- **Follow Cty ES east.** Visit Wisconsin's largest farm market, The Elegant Farmer, for fresh apples or their famous apple pie.
- **Continue east on Cty ES to Mukwonago. Pick up Hwy 83 north to Hwy 167 east.** The rolling hills of the Kettle Moraine State Forest lead you to Holy Hill and the National Shrine of Mary. Follow the winding road up to this hilltop church for a spectacular view.
- **Return to Hwy 167 east to Hwy 45 south to I-94 east to downtown Milwaukee.**

8. БЕЛОИТ TO MILWAUKEE

- **Take I-90 west to Cty S, Exit east to Shopiere.** Look for the unique 5-arched stone bridge spanning Turtle Creek.
- **Turn Left on Cty J and then right on Creek Rd.** Pass wildlife areas and get glimpses of Turtle Creek.
- **Turn right on Hwy 14 then left on Sharon-Darien Townline Rd.** Continue to South Shore Drive and turn left. Follow the tree-lined shoreline of Delevan Lake.
- **Take Hwy 50 east towards Lake Geneva.** Watch for the brown and gold Rustic Road sign on the right for a short scenic loop that brings you back to Hwy 50. In Lake Geneva have lunch at a lakeside café or walk past historic mansions on the lakeshore path.
- **Take Broad Street north to Hwy 120 north to Hwy 36 north.** In Burlington Adrian's Frozen Custard is the place the locals go to cool off. Have a little time to spare? Rochester, west on Cty D, offers great local dining, shops and a pretty view of the Fox River.
- **Continue on Hwy 36 north to I-43 north to downtown Milwaukee.**
